

**SHERMAN LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

FEBRUARY 5, 2008

The Sherman Liquor Control Commission went into a special meeting at 8:25 p.m. on Tuesday, February 5th for the purpose of hearing about a liquor control violation. All board members were present. President Trevor J. Clatfelter presided.

Police Officer Jerry Schneider told the board that on January 27th at 2:04 p.m., while doing a check to make sure doors were locked, he noticed that 5 people were in the Final Four Bar, and were drinking alcohol. The bar owner was not present. Mr. Runyon, bartender, told Mr. Schneider, when asked why people were in the bar after 1:00 p.m., that they were helping him to clean up. Clatfelter said village ordinances call for a fine of \$50 to \$500. As this is a first time offence, he recommended a letter to the bar owner and a \$50 fine. It was noted that the bar owner had been told that the liquor commission would be meeting on this date concerning the violation. Zibutis made a motion, seconded by Mitchell and carried unanimously by the Commission, to approve the suggestion of a letter and a \$50 fine to the bar owner. At 8:40 p.m. the Commission voted to adjourn the meeting.
