A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF WHS 1 PERCENT SANGAMON COUNTY WIDE SCHOOL FACILITY SALES TAX REFERENDUM

WHEREAS, The Sherman Village Board works tirelessly to promote the Village of Sherman as a great place to live, raise a family, and conduct business and supports initiatives that fit that mission; and

WHEREAS, state school funding is insufficient in Illinois to ensure school districts can fully fund their operations and properly maintain their buildings; and

WHEREAS, Sangamon County School Districts have approved a resolution asking that a question be put on the ballot asking voters to approve a 1 percent countywide school facility sales tax that would be divided amongst Sangamon County school districts based on enrollment and used exclusively for school buildings and facilities; and

WHEREAS, Williamsville-Sherman CUSD #15 would receive an estimated \$1,060,000 a year from this additional 1 percent tax, to be used to maintain and upgrade the school facilities in Williamsville and Sherman; and

WHEREAS, our Village is a stronger place to live and do business when we have a vibrant, viable and financially supported school district with updated and safe facilities for our children; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Sangamon County will ultimately decide whether to approve the 1 percent county wide school facility sales tax question, and its approval would fully support the Village of Sherman's efforts behind a better future through suitable school facilities that will be attractive to young families;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherman wish to show our support for the 1 percent county wide school facility sales tax that would be divided amongst Sangamon County school districts based on enrollment and used exclusively for school buildings and facilities.
