Our History

In 1858, four men, Virgil Hickox, Cornelius Flagg, Joseph Ledlie and David Sherman bought, surveyed, and platted what is now called Sherman. The town's name was a result of the luck of the draw. The four men placed their names in a hat and David Sherman's name was drawn. One of the subdivisions in Sherman designated as Flaggland Parks, was named after Cornelius Flagg.

Early settlers in Sherman were predominantly Italian and involved in the coal mining industry. Sherman was incorporated as a village in 1959 with a population of 209 people. John Jerome served as the first village president and held the position until his death in 1978. Sherwood Zimmerman was appointed to fill out the term and held the office until 1987. In April of 1987 Frank Meredith was elected as the Village President. Trevor Clatfelter was elected Village President in May 2007 and remains in that position today.

During the 1970's, Sherman began to grow due to its proximity to Springfield and Interstate 55. Sherman's first growth was primarily residential. Sherman continues this

growth pattern today and currently has a population of a little under 5,000.

The Village is a little-known location of a small unused portion of the original Illinois portion of Route 66. This segment underscores the fast-paced evolution of Route 66 in Illinois. Designated as a part of the Mother Road in 1926, it was quickly replaced in 1930 with a major realignment to the east.

Sherman is the home of the Rail Golf Course. It is a championship 18-hole course which until 2007 hosted the annual Labor Day Rail Charity Golf Classic, the second longest running golf tournament in LPGA history. The event drew thousands of visitors to Sherman annually and generated nearly two million dollars for local charities.

Sherman is considered a family-oriented community with many organized youth activities. The school system is consolidated with the Village of Williamsville, which has a proud history of excellence in education and athletic success.

Water Bill Payments

The water system is run by the Village of Williamsville. There are numerous options available for you to pay your water bill:

- Water bills may also be paid through a direct deposit payment option with the Village of
 Williamsville. To sign up go to https://williamsville.illinois.gov/how-to-pay-your-water-bill.html.
 Water bills can be paid at the Sherman branch of the Williamsville State Bank and Trust whether you are a client of the bank or not.

Branch & Limb Pick Up

The Village of Sherman offers a branch and limb pick-up program for its residents. You are asked to place the limbs at the curbside for pickup by 6:00 AM the day of the scheduled pick-up. *Note: Limb size is to be no longer than 8 feet and no more than a small truck load. Entire trees are not accepted, this requires the services of professional tree removers. Limbs trimmed by professional tree services will not be picked up. The Village does not accept grass clippings, leaves, weeds, etc. (Contact your waste hauler for more information).*

Grinder Pump Failure

The Village's Grinder Pump Sanitary Sewer System was originally chosen for use in Birch Lakes Subdivision and other areas of the Village as the most cost-effective way to provide service. The Village has approximately 135 grinder pumps to take care of. The reason we need grinder pumps is that they grind solid waste up so it can be pumped through the sewer line.

Grinder Pumps Have Limitations. There are certain things that can cause damage to the grinder pump. Damaged grinder pumps not working property due to misuse can cause back up into the home. This can cause serious damage, unsanitary conditions and costly service fees and fines. To aoid this from happening use common sense and DO NOT FLUSH the following items down the toilet. Dispose of these and similar items into the garbage.

- Grease from cooked food, glass, metal, toys, gravel/sand, coffee grinds, kitty litter;
- Female sanitary products, diapers, baby wipes, floor cleaning pads,
- Rags, plastic, personal wipes including so called "flushable wipes",
- Small solid objects, paper towels, string or other similar items.

If you see a grinder pump light on or have any issue with a grinder pump, please call public works duty phone 217-306-5751. Failure to follow the rules will result in failure of the pump and fines.

Permits & Licenses

Permits are required in the Village please do not forget since this ordinance violation results in a fine which is enforced. Applications and further information are available on the Village Website (https://www.shermanil.org). Permits are needed for:

- Residential and Commercial construction
- Outdoor cafes
- Liquor licenses
- Video gaming
- Signage/signs
- Block Parties

NOTE: Peddler Permits are not issued within the Village of Sherman.

Open Burning of Landscape Waste

In 2008 the Village of Sherman adopted a Burn Ordinance. This ordinance specifies the ban burning of materials, grass, garbage, litter, recyclable materials, construction materials, and other substances within the Village limits except for as provided by Village ordinance.

Please refer to the Village Website (https://www.shermanil.org) for a list of precise burning dates which usually run through the months of March 1st through April 30th & September 15th through November 30th. Remember burning is only allowed on those permitted days from 9:00 a.m. until sunset. For your safety and safety of others please burn responsibly. Follow the rules outlined, burn only on days allowed, and follow any required wind restrictions.

Problem Reporting through Sherman 311

The Sherman 311 phone app permits residents and visitors to report a variety of public problems such as potholes, broken streetlamps, vandalism, fly dumping, etc. The app permits the user to access government officials via email or telephone while also providing other important government information. Prescription Drug Disposal Program

The Prescription Drug Disposal vault is located at the Sherman Police Department (2629 W. Andrew Road), main entrance lobby, right inside the door. It is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (24/7).

Items Accepted

- Prescription medications (excepted controlled*)
- All over-the-counter medications
- Pet medications
- Vitamins & Supplements
- Medicated ointments, lotions, creams & oils
- Liquid medication in leak-proof containers
- Homeopathic Remedies
- Suppositories

Items Not Accepted

- Needles/sharps
- Syringes with needles
- Thermometers
- Controlled* prescriptions
- IV bags
- Bloody or infectious waste
- Personal care products
- Empty containers
- Hydrogen Peroxide
- Aerosol cans
- Full inhalers

^{*} Any drug as defined in the five categories of the federal Controlled Substances Act of 1970. These medications are categorized by "schedules" based on their potential for abuse or addiction. They range from Schedule I, or CI (illegal drugs) to C2 to C5 which indicates a decrease in potential for abuse or addiction. The schedules cover opium (and other opiates), hallucinogens, as well as prescriptions containing narcotics or amphetamines.

The Village of Sherman has approximately 100 acres of park and recreation areas dispersed throughout the community. In addition, the Village Board continues to expand potential for additional sites and facilities for our residents to enjoy. Sherman Village Park covers 100 acres of land containing:

- State of the art playground and Splash Pad,

- Lighted 1-mile walking trail.
