Dear Mr. Mayor,

I am requesting on behalf of the Sherman Fire Protection District \$22,283.70 from village TIF funds that will be used to purchase:

- 5 Zoll Pro Automated External Defibrillators at \$2,928.74 each, Total Cost: \$14,643.70, and
- 8 Scott SCBA replacement bottles with 4500 psi Valve Assemblies at \$955.00 each, Total Cost: \$7,640.00

The ZOLL AED Pro supports Basic Life Support as well as Advanced Life Support professionals. This advanced AED features a high-resolution LCD display that allows responders to visualize a patient's ECG while utilizing a 3-lead monitoring cable. The ZOLL AED Pro includes a real-time feedback mechanism, known as Real CPR Help®, which allows rescuers to see and hear how well they are performing the rate and depth of chest compressions during CPR. Real CPR Help includes a metronome set at the AHA recommended 100 bpm and a screen display which helps rescuers achieve optimum rate and depth of compression levels through audible and/or visual prompts. These will be replacements for our current older model AED's that will be no longer authorized for use by the Food and Drug Administration.

The eight (8) replacement Scott SCBA bottles are necessary to replace eight bottles that are out of date and can no longer be certified to be filled. These were fifteen-year bottles that will be replaced with bottles with a thirty-year life span saving the district money in the future.

I would be happy to meet with you and the full board to discuss these pressing needs.
