AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT is hereby made and entered into this ______day of _______day of ________, 2020, by and between the State of Illinois, acting and by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the "STATE", and the Village of Sherman, hereinafter called the "VILLAGE", and the Sangamon County Water Reclamation District, formerly known as the Springfield Metro Sanitary District, hereinafter called the "DISTRICT".

WHEREAS, the STATE and the DISTRICT are parties to a certain agreement dated the 28th day of April, 1982, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the STATE, VILLAGE, and DISTRICT are parties to a certain agreement dated the 27th day of May, 1987, copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE under Resolution NO. 1986-1 has agreed to accept ownership and responsibility for the maintenance and operation of the sanitary sewer line referred to in Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree that the agreement of April 28, 1982 shall remain in effect except as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 5 of said April 28, 1982 agreement attached as Exhibit A, shall be null and avoid and replaced with paragraph 2 below.
- 2. Upon completion of the improvement to the satisfaction of the VILLAGE and the STATE, the STATE agrees to initiate legislation in the Illinois General Assembly to assign and transfer to the VILLAGE all of its interest in the 8-inch diameter gravity-flow sanitary sewer main and appurtenances, constructed as part of this improvement and including all rights in permanent easement acquired to construct the improvement.
- 3. Paragraph 6 of said April 28, 1982 agreement attached as Exhibit A shall be null and void and replaced with paragraph 4 below.
- 4. Upon assignment and transfer of the interests set forth in paragraph 5 above, the VILLAGE agrees to accept the assignment and transfer of these interests and to operate and maintain the 8-inch diameter gravity-flow sanitary sewer main and appurtenances constructed as part of the improvement.

The DISTRICT agrees not to construct or permit others to construct additional service connections or taps into the sanitary sewer main constructed as part of this improvement, which taps would exceed the capacity of the sewer main, or to interfere with service to the Rest Area.

5. This AGREEMENT shall be binding upon the PARTIES hereto, their successors or assigns.

6. This AGREEMENT shall be construed and interpreted according to the laws of the State of Illinois.

- Upon completion of the improvement to the satisfaction of the VILLAGE and the STATE, the STATE agrees to initiate legislation in the Illinois General Assembly to assign and transfer to the VILLAGE all of its interest in the 8-inch diameter gravity-flow sanitary sewer main and appurconstructed as part of this improvement and tenances, including all rights in permanent easement acquired to construct the improvement.
- Paragraph 6 of said April 28, 1982 agreement shall be null and void replaced with paragraph 4 below.
- Upon assignment and transfer of the interests set forth in paragraph 2 above, the VILLAGE agrees to accept the assignment and transfer of these interests and to operate and maintain the 8-inch diameter gravity-flow sanitary sewer main and appurtences constructed as part of improvement.

The DISTRICT agrees not to construct or permit others to construct additional service connections or taps into the sanitary sewer main constructed as part of this improvement, which taps would exceed the capacity of the sewer main, or to interfere with service to the Rest Area.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the STATE owns and operates a Rest Area to serve outhbound traffic on F.A.I. Route 55, in Sangamon County, south f Sherman, Illinois and proposes to improve sewage disposal from he said Rest Area, by an improvement known as F.A.I. Route 55, struction of an 8-inch diameter gravity-flow sanitary sewer main from proposed DISTRICT facilities to the Rest Area; and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT is agreeable to supply sanitary sewer service to the Rest Area; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement supersedes and replaces an Agreement between the STATE and the DISTRICT, dated June 8, 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- The STATE agrees to make the surveys, obtain all necessary right-of-way, prepare plans and specifications, secure all necessary permits, receive bids and award the contract, furnish engineering inspection during construction and cause the improvement to be built in accordance with the plans, specifications and contract, and provide to the District "as-built" construction drawings and results of a leakage test certified by a Professional Engineer.
 - The STATE agrees to pay all right-of-way, construction and engineering costs for the construction of the 8-inch diameter gravity-flow sanitary sewer main for the sanitary sewer service from the proposed DISTRICT facilities to the
 - The STATE agrees to pay the customary user charges, including year-end review charges and any required tap-on charges at the rates that are currently in effect in the DISTRICT and to comply with the same rules and regulations for sanitary sewer service as all other patrons of the DISTRICT.
 - Prior to the STATE's advertising for work to be performed hereunder, the DISTRICT agrees to provide approval of the plans and specifications by Resolution or Letter.

- 5. *Upon completion of the improvement to the mututal satisfaction of the DISTRICT and the STATE, the STATE agrees to initiate legislation in the Illinois General Assembly to assign and transfer to the DISTRICT all of its interest in the 8-inch diameter gravity-flow sanitary sewer main and appurtenances, constructed as part of this improvement and including all rights in permanent easements acquired to construct the improvement.
 - 6. Upon assignment and transfer of the interests set forth in paragraph 5 above, the DISTRICT agrees to accept the assignment and transfer of these interests and to operate and maintain the 8-inch diameter gravity-flow sanitary sewer main and appurtenances constructed as part of this improvement.

The DISTRICT further agrees not to construct or permit others to construct additional service connections or taps into the sanitary sewer main constructed as part of this improvement, which taps would exceed the capacity of the sewer main, or to interfere with service to the Rest Area.

- 7. The STATE agrees to the annexation of the Rest Area property within six (6) months after said property becomes contiguous to the DISTRICT'S boundary.
- 8. This Agreement and the covenants contained herein shall be null and void in the event the contract covering the construction contemplated herein is not awarded by June 30, 1984.

This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois Department of Transportation presently operates and maintains an existing 8 inch sanitary sewer line servicing the location of the Interstate 55 rest area located within the Village of Sherman, which line runs Southeasterly from the rest area 4308 feet to the Springfield Sanitary District Sherman East Pumping Station and which line also includes 13 manholes which are considered a part thereof; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois Department of Transportation wishes to transfer responsibility for the ownership, operation and maintenance of said sanitary sewer line, which line does not meet current standards of the Springfield Sanitary District; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village of Sherman to accept the ownership and responsibility for the maintenance and operation of said sanitary sewer line in order to be able to integrate said sewer line into the proposed sewer system to be constructed within the Village of Sherman; provided that the Village of Sherman shall not accept said obligation until such time as it shall be able to use and operate said sewer line in connection with the use and operation of its own municipal sewer system and provided that the Village of Sherman shall have assurances from the Springfield Sanitary District that it will allow the Village of Sherman to operate and maintain the sewer line in its existing location, design and condition.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Sherman, Sherman, Illinois:

1. That it is the intent of the Village of Sherman to accept ownership and responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the 8 inch sanitary sewer line and manholes described above subject to the condition that the Village of Sherman shall not accept such obligations until such time as it shall be able to use and operate said sewer line in connection with the use and operation of its own municipal sewer system and provided that the Village of Sherman shall have assurances from the Springfield

Sanitary District that it will allow the Village of Sherman to operate and maintain the sewer line in its existing location, design and condition.




