1. Roll Call. Clerk Stratton called roll call. President Clatfelter noted Trustee Hahn and Trustee Long had an excused absence. President Clatfelter noted a quorum was present to conduct Village business.
2. Pledge of Allegiance. Village Administrator Stratton led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ACTION ITEM

1. Resolution RE: Approval of Agreement with IDOT for Business 55 Repaving & Traffic Control Project. President Clatfelter addressed the Board about the meeting held with IDOT Representatives on the design plans for Business 55 repaving, curbing and traffic intersections that the Village has been asking for years to be improved.
