Our Village Clean Up Day is for SHERMAN RESIDENTS ONLY! Please have your ID ready for proof of residency and please be patient as this is one of our busiest programs offered to Village Residents. Follow the arrows and instructions from volunteers. Volunteers will be easy to spot as they will be dawned in bright neon vests ready to accept your items. **EVENT STARTS AT 8AM AND ENDS PRECISELY AT 11AM.**

## Items Accepted FOR A FEE

Credit Voucher for BLH will be provided for items charged a fee. Fee schedule for specialized items are:

- \$10 per CRT monitor
- \$20 per standard CRT TVs
- \$20 per non-LCD/plasma televisions or monitors
- \$40 per projection TV/console TV

## Items NOT Accepted

- Microwaves, toasters, and other small kitchen appliances
- Refrigerators, stoves, and other large appliances
- Broken IVs (broken glass or otherwise dismantled)
- Lamps/light bulbs
- Vacuum and floor cleaners
- Toys
- General rubbish
- Audio and video cassettes
- CDs and DVDs
- Software
- Carbon Monoxide/smoke detectors
- Bathroom devices (i.e. electric razors, toothbrushes, etc.)
- Gas powered tools
- Glass, Christmas light bulbs, etc.
- Mercury thermometers
- Thermostats
- Aerosol cans
- Lava lamps
- Pressurized canisters of any kind
- Live ammunition
- Needles of any sort
- Adhesives, paints, chemicals of any kind
- Alkaline batteries (AAAA, AAA, AA, C, D, etc.)
