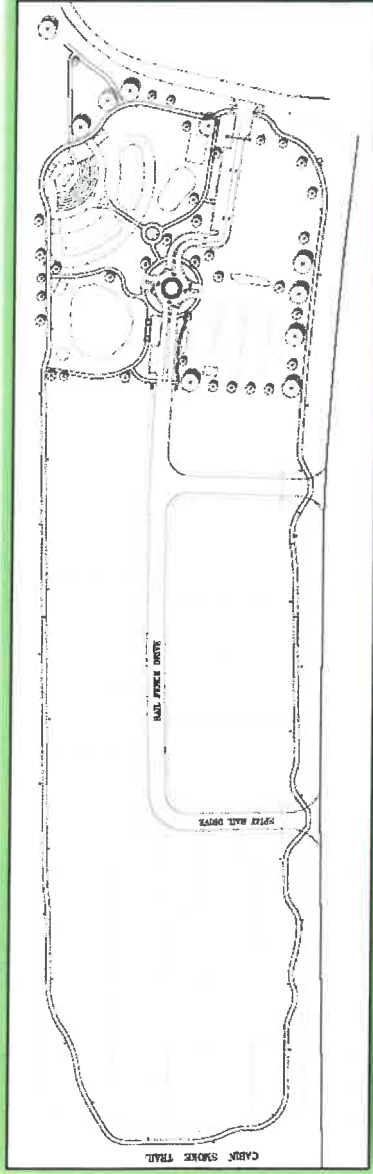

Sherman's Park Bench Donation Program

Your Bench Plaque Tells a Story as each plaque is 2" x 7" allowing you to memorialize a certain person, place or date.

Park benches are the color of redwood and are six-foot long. The bench is made from recycled materials which provide UV protection requiring minimum maintenance.

The price includes: bench, plaque, concrete pad, delivery and installation.

Cost of each bench is \$750.00.

The Bench Program Coordinator or their representative will contact you upon receipt of the funds to coordinate the location of your bench.

Village of Sherman ★ Park Bench Donation Program

The Village invites residents to participate in the Park Bench Donation Program to enhance our community by improving our parks and trails.

Bench Donation Terms and Conditions

1. This program is designed to enable residents and park users to support the Village of Sherman through a park bench donation program. A bench donation will be accepted only for placement of a bench and location identified by the Village Parks & Recreation Committee. The Committee will work with the Donor to select a bench site from the site plan.
2. Commemorative plaques installed on benches must be for an individual or a purpose that is non-controversial with text that is appropriate for display in a public place, and approved by the Parks & Recreation Committee.
3. Donations will be acknowledged by a plaque affixed to the bench. The plaque of the donation does not entitle the donor to ownership of the particular or any other donated bench.
4. Donation forms will be accepted throughout the year.
5. Payment is required in full with the application. The donation for a commemorative Park Bench shall be \$750.00. The cost covers: 6 foot bench, delivery and placement on concrete pad, and 2"x7" engraved plaque.
6. The Committee representative will finalize, with the donor, the proposed locations available for placement.
7. A maximum of 4 lines of text and 40 characters per line is permitted on the dedication plaque. Text is subject to the approval of the Parks & Recreation Committee.
8. The Committee will inventory, date, a record of all existing donated benches and plaques that have been requested, ordered and installed. A copy of these records will be filed with the Village Clerk every time it is updated.
