ORDINANCE NO. 2017-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2017-2 AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO BORROW MONEY TO PURCHASE A JOHN DEERE 4052R TRACTOR AND ATTACHMENTS

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code and further is operating as a home-rule municipality pursuant to and with all powers under Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, Section 8-1-3.1, authorizes the Village to borrow money from any bank or other financial institution provided such money shall be repaid within 10 years from the time the money is borrowed; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to borrow money for the purpose of purchasing a new John Deere 4052R Tractor with Attachments to be utilized by the Village Public Works Department and herein approve of said loan and purchase; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2017-2 authorized the purchase and borrowing of money for the John Deere 4052R Tractor, but did not yet specify specific terms on the loan; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village desire to amend Ordinance 2017-2 to specify where the money will be borrowed from, as well as the maximum repayment term and amount.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Amendment. Section 2 of Ordinance 2017-2 shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

Section 2. Authority to Borrow Money. The Village President is authorized to execute a promissory note or similar debt instrument, but not a bond, for the purposes of borrowing money in an amount not to exceed \$72,000.00 for the purpose of purchasing a John Deere 4052R Tractor with a cab and multiple attachments, specifically including a John Deere H180 Loader, NSL, H/Guard, HD73" Bucket; Frontier 1012RAII Flex Mower; Frontier SB3108 7FT 8" Sickle Mower; and Frontier 2172 HYO Broom, to be utilized by the Village Public Works Department from Illinois National Bank, which is a lending institution subject to the Illinois Banking Act or Illinois Savings and Loan Act of 1985 or other "financial institution" authorized by Section 8-1-3.1 of the Municipal Code. The term of the loan shall not exceed five (5) years. The Village President, or his designees, is also authorized to sign other related documentation to effectuate the purchase and/or loan from Illinois National Bank.

Section 3. Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Sherman prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
