ORDINANCE NO. 2026-04

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE BID TO FINANCE THE PURCHASE OF 2026 CHEVY TAHOE PPV FOR SHERMAN POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code and further is operating as a home-rule municipality pursuant to and with all powers under Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, Section 8-1-3.1, authorizes the Village to borrow money from any bank or other financial institution provided such money shall be repaid within 10 years from the time the money is borrowed; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village desire to borrow money for the purpose of purchasing a 2026 Chevy Tahoe PPV for its Police Department and herein approve of said loan; and

WHEREAS, bids were solicited from local/area financial institutions to finance up to \$70,000 for the purchase of 2026 Chevy Tahoe PPV and accessory purchases and installations; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Authority to Borrow Money. The Village President is authorized to execute a promissory note or similar debt instrument with Hickory Point Bank for the purposes of borrowing money in an amount \$70,000 at rate of 4.70% for the purpose of

financing the purchase of a 2026 Chevy Tahoe PPV and purchase and install the necessary equipment required for its Sherman Police Department. The term of the loan shall not exceed five (5) years and will be set up as an ACH from the Village Operating Account.

Section 3. Repeal and Savings Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Sherman prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


