**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 8-3A-8
OF THE SHERMAN CODE OF ORDINANCES**

*BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
SHERMAN, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:*

SECTION 1: Whereas, the Village previously adopted an ordinance governing the operation of a grinder pump system for the village wastewater treatment system, and

SECTION 2: Whereas the Village has now invested in a new system to upgrade the services provided to the residents of the Village, and the requirements of Section 8-3A-8(B) are no longer necessary

SECTION 3: Section 8-3A-8(B) of the Sherman Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is effective upon its passage and publication. The Clerk shall publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.
