

RESOLUTION 23-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF POLICE BODY AND VEHICLE CAMERAS AS MANDATED BY STATE LAW & PROCEED TO APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING TO OFFSET COST OF COMPLIANCE

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman operates a law enforcement agency in accordance with State law;

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois passed legislation at 50 ILCS 706 Law Enforcement Officer-Worn Body Camera Act mandating that all law enforcement agencies police officers are required to wear on-duty body cameras by 2025;

WHEREAS, police administrative staff have identified a vendor, Midwest Public Safety, that specializes in body cameras and related gear that can provide body cameras and related gear to comply with the State mandate in an amount no greater than \$57,000;


WHEREAS, police administrative staff have identified grant funding available to offset the costs of body cameras and related gear;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Village of Sherman Board of Trustees authorize the President to proceed to purchase mandated on-duty cameras and other required vehicle cameras to comply with State law and further encourages the application for available grant funds to offset the costs associated with complying with this mandate;
