ORDINANCE NO. 23-02

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN VEHICLES OF THE VILLAGE OF SHERMAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and isnowoperating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and

WHEREAS the corporate authorities of each municipality may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities, with such fines or penalties as may be deemed proper; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, grants municipalities with a population less than 500,000, the authority to sell and dispose of personal property it determines, by a simple majority of the corporate authorities, to be no longer useful and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman has a 2010 Ford Expedition that is no longer of use or necessary for the Village operations; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman was presented a bid for the purchase of the 2010 Ford Expedition in the amount of \$5,000 from Central Service Center; and

WHEREAS The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherman find that the vehicle set forth in this Resolution is no longer useful or necessary and ownership shall be transferred as set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are incorporated herein by this reference as if specifically stated in full.

Section 2. <u>Disposition of Property.</u> The property listed above is hereby declared to be surplus property by the Village. In consideration of current value and condition of the vehicle and an offer above NADA value the Village Authorizes the Sale to

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Sherman prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. <u>Effectiveness</u>. This ordinance is effective immediately.
