ORDINANCE NO. 2020-07

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A ONE YEAR EXTENSION TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE ILLINOIS FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE LABOR COUCIL

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman ("Village") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman and the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council approved a collective bargaining agreement that expired on April 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman and the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council have met on numerous occasions since the expiration of the collective bargaining agreement to negotiate in good faith a new collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman and Illinois Fraternal Order of Police mutually agree to a one-year extension of the current collective bargaining agreement through April 30, 2020,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherman, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Extension of Collective Bargaining Agreement & Payment of Wages. The Village agrees to extend the current labor agreement to April 30, 2020 and pay wage increases to members of the collective bargaining agreement in an amount equal to 3% of their pay retroactive to May 1, 2019. By so doing, there will be

no negotiation of other wages, benefits or hours of work prior or retroactive April 30, 2020.

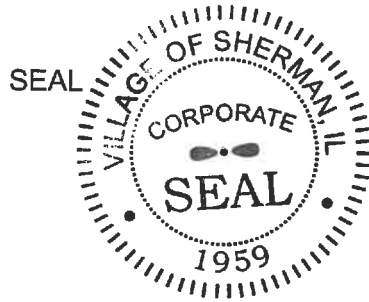
Section 3. Repeal. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are in conflict with this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or under any circumstances is adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or of any portion not adjudged invalid.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law where indicated on the Attached Exhibit A.
