ORDINANCE NO. 2022-06

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE SUNSET PROVISIONS OF THE VILLAGE CODE AND LIQUOR CODE ON VIDEO GAMING TO SUNSET AND BE REPEALED EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020, UNLESS RE-AUTHORIZED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF SHERMAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code and further is operating as a home-rule municipality pursuant to and with all powers under Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, The Village Board previously approved Ordinance NO. 2012-11 and 2012-12 enacting certain provisions allowing video gaming within the Village of Sherman; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board previously adopted an ordinance establishing sunset provisions of the Village Code provisions allowing video gaming and the Village Liquor Code provisions establishing a Class "VG" license, to sunset and be repealed effective July 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that there are certain costs and negative impacts associated with allowing video gaming within the Village that requires consistent re-evaluation of whether such is beneficial and should be allowed and permitted within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Video Gaming Act, 230 ILCS 40/27, provides that a municipality may pass an ordinance prohibiting video gaming within the corporate limits of the

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Sherman believe it is in best interests of the Village that the provision of the Village Code and Village Liquor Code on video gaming sunset on July 1, 2022, and thus no longer be in effect, unless such ordinances are specifically re-authorized by the Village Board.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Effectiveness. After its passage, this Ordinance shall be effective and commence 10 days after this Ordinance is printed in book or pamphlet form and published by the authority of the corporate authorities and shall thereafter remain effective until July 1, 2023 at which time this Ordinance shall no longer be in effect unless reauthorized by the Village Board of Trustees in a separate re-authorization ordinance.

Section 4. <u>Severability.</u> In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 5. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Sherman prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provide by law.
