AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE NUMBER OF CLASS A LIQUOR LICENSES AVAILABLE WITHIN THE VILLAGE UNDER THE VILLAGE LIQUOR CODE

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code and further is operating as a homerule municipality pursuant to and with all powers under Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman (hereinafter, the "Village"), is an Illinois municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, sets forth the rights of municipalities to govern and restrict the sale of alcoholic liquor within their communities; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2 of the Act provides that the Village has the authority to determine the number, kind and classification of licenses for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor, not inconsistent with the Act, and the amount of local licensee fees to be paid for the various kinds of licenses to be issued; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2 of the Act provides that the Village has the authority to establish such further regulations and restrictions upon the issuance of a local license not inconsistent with the law as the public good and convenience may require; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees previously adopted provisions set forth in Chapter 2 of Title IV of the Village Code limiting the number of various liquor license classifications; and

WHEREAS. The Corporate Authorities of the Village Believe it is in the best interest of the Village to increase the number of Class A licenses.

NOW THERFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated into and made part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. <u>Amendment to Village Code – Number of Class A Licenses.</u> Chapter 2 of Title IV, Section 4-2-6 of the Village Code shall be amended by increasing the number of Class A licenses from 1 to 2.

Section 3. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction finds this ordinance or any provision hereof to be invalid or unenforceable as applied, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and the application thereof to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 4. Repeal and Savings Clause. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Sherman prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. <u>Effectiveness.</u> This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
