

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-11

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENTS OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE VILLAGE OF SHERMAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Sherman, Sangamon County, Illinois (the “Village”), is a duly organized and existing municipality under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.1-30-5 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-5, authorizes the Village President, with the advice and consent of the Board of Trustees, to appoint officers necessary to carry into effect the powers conferred upon the Village; and

WHEREAS, Sections 6-1-1 and 6-1-2 of the Village Code provide that the Village President shall appoint the Chief of Police, subject to the consent of the Board of Trustees, and that the Chief of Police shall discharge the duties imposed by law and designated by the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the orderly administration of the Sherman Police Department and continuity of command require qualified leadership in the offices of Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, Village President Trevor J. Clatfelter has appointed **Aaron J Entringer** to the rank and position of Chief of Police, subject to the advice, consent, approval, and confirmation of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that the appointee is qualified to serve and that confirmation of the appointment is in the best interests of the Village and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SHERMAN, SANGAMON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Confirmation of Chief of Police. The appointment of **Aaron Entringer** by Village President Trevor J. Clatfelter to the office of Chief of Police of the Village of Sherman is hereby advised, consented to, approved, and confirmed, effective upon passage and approval of this Resolution.

Section 3. Authority and Duties. The Chief of Police shall exercise the powers and perform the duties assigned to their respective offices by applicable federal and state law, the Village Code, resolutions and policies of the Village, and the lawful directives of the Village President and Board of Trustees.

Section 5. Compensation and Employment Terms. Compensation, benefits, and other terms applicable to the appointment shall be those established or approved by the Board of Trustees through the Village’s salary ordinance, budget, personnel policies, or other lawful action, as applicable. Nothing in this Resolution creates a fixed term of employment or limits any authority otherwise provided by law.

Section 6. Administrative Authorization. The Village President, Village Clerk or Deputy Village Clerk, Village Administrator, and other appropriate Village officials are authorized and directed to execute any documents and take any actions reasonably necessary to carry out this Resolution, including administration of any oath required by law and updating Village records, credentials, and command designations.

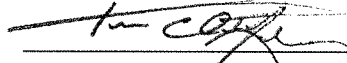
Section 7. Severability and Repealer. If any provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
