

Outdoor Glazed Ceramic Planter Donation Terms and Conditions

- This program is designed to enable residents and park users to support the Village of Sherman through a park glazed ceramic planter donation program. A planter donation will be accepted only for placement of a glazed ceramic planter and location identified by the Village Parks & Recreation Committee. The Committee will work with the Donor to select a planter site from the site plan.
- 2. Commemorative plaques installed on glazed ceramic planter must be for an individual or a purpose that is non-controversial with text that is appropriate for display in a public place, and approved by the Parks & Recreation Committee.
- 3. Donations will be acknowledged by a plaque affixed to the planter. The plaque of the donation does not entitle the donor to ownership of the particular or any other donated planter.
- 4. Donation forms will be accepted throughout the year.
- 5. Payment is required in full with the application. The donation for a commemorative Park Glazed ceramic planter shall be \$325.00. The cost covers: glazed ceramic planter, delivery and placement on concrete pad, 2 1/2"x5" engraved plaque, potting soil and plants. Volunteers will plant planters.
- 6. The Committee representative will finalize, with the donor, the proposed locations available for placement.
- 7. A maximum of 4 lines of text and 40 characters per line is permitted on the dedication plaque. Text is subject to the approval of the Parks & Recreation Committee.
- 8. The Committee will inventory, date, a record of all existing donated planters and plaques that have been requested,
